

## **Appendix 1 Medicine and Dentistry Selection Sub-**

### **Committee Academic Lead, Selection**

The Academic Lead, Selection reports to the Chair of the Committee

The role of the Academic Lead, Selection is to:

- Seek input from the subcommittee in advance and represent the University and the Faculty on national committees, in particular the UCAT Test Management Committee and the GAMSAT Policy Committee, and other committees/subcommittees as the situation arises;
- Report back to the committee in writing, on the agenda, discussions, and decisions following attendance at relevant external committees (see above)
- Undertake and report evaluation and research into the outcomes of local selection policies and to participate in national research projects in association with interstate colleagues;
- Monitor student intakes and report statistics to the committee, Heads of Schools and Faculty Learning and Teaching Committees;
- Undertake and report analysis of relevant data to inform future decisions on any student Admissions or performance changes proposed, and
- In consultation with the committee oversee the development of interview questions, structure and training of new and returning interviewers or the details of a selection process substituted for interviews.

The role should occupy around 0.15 FTE between the Service and Research components of an T&R workload, including external Service.

Expressions of interest in the role should come from academic staff, and must include relevant experience

Any appointment will require approval from the relevant Head of School/Manager

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
